Deadlines:

- March 15th for mobility in the second semester
- October 15th for mobility in the first semester

- Motivation Letter
- Curriculum Vitae
- Academic Transcript
- Certificate of Proficiency in Portuguese or a similar statement (upper intermediate level at least)
- Recommendation Letter from a professor
- Copy of the identification page of the passport
- Application form¹

Academic Information

Assessment Requirement:

Bachelor Programs:

- minimum passing grade: 7.00
- minimum class attendance: 75%

Credit System:

1 credit is equivalent to 1 contact hour (1 class hour = 50 minutes)

Transcripts:

Transcript of records will be sent to the student's home institution up to 2 months after the end of the academic semester

In Brazil we speak Portuguese!

Language Requirements

The participants in the student exchange program should present a certificate of proficiency or a similar statement issued by a language school, university or by a professor proving that they have at least the upper intermediate level in Portuguese language.

Health insurance (mandatory):

The participants in the student exchange program must acquire and send a copy of a health insurance before the beginning of the program.

Student Visa (mandatory):

Student visa is mandatory for purposes of studies over 3 months. Once the application is approved by the academic coordinator, an acceptance letter will be sent to the student's home institution. The student is responsible for obtaining all information about the procedures and documents required to apply for visa in the Brazilian Consulate closest to his/her home address. Housing: Santa Marcelina does not have dormitories on campus. The student should arrange his/her own housing.
